- A solution containing chemical and plant agents, as well as anesthetic, is injected into dimpled areas. It is said to break down fat and block the production of new fat cells in the mesoderm layer of skin.

- An enzyme called phosphatidyl choline (aka Lipostabil) is injected into fatty areas, like the butt and thighs, where it is said to break down and dissolve fat, slimming and smoothing the skin.

- A machine with large rollers (made by a company called LPG) massages the skin to break up fat. It has been FDA-approved for the temporary reduction of the

- There have been no published studies using the enzyme on the butt and thigh areas. There is, however, anecdotal evidence of its success in South America, where the treatment is popular.

- In a one-year clinical-outcome-study update published in the *Aesthetic Plastic Surgery Journal* in 1998, 90 percent of participants reported an improvement in areas

- According to Steven Victor, M.D., a New York City cosmetic dermatologist, most patients require up to six sessions to see results. For more information, see "Beauty Treatment—or Torture?" on p. 220.

- The sensation of the rolling machines is similar to deep-tissue massage. Temporary bruising may occur. You will need 14 sessions (two per week) to see results that could

- The injections are said to be painless. After the fat is treated, it is excreted in urine. You will need a minimum of 10 treatments, one per week, to see results. Maintenance shots may be required.

the heat physician, Caroline Gubaud, M.D., said: "After 10 sessions, all subjects noticed a visible improvement in the 'orange peel' texture of the skin."

the cellulite cells are current said to break down and drain toxins. You may see results after the first session. Maintenance treatments are required.

- "Although liposuction alone does not address cellulite per se, I have seen minor improvements with this combination," says Debra B. Luftman, M.D., a Beverly Hills dermatologist.

- Both procedures can be performed in the same visit but must be administered by a qualified liposuction doctor (to find one, go to www.adf.org). Expect five days of severe bruising. ▶
